



The Shepherd's Voice


is a day-long retreat on hearing God. A teaching on *The Still Small Voice*, showing the biblical pattern of God speaking in quietness to the individual, launches the course. From there, the classical discipline of *Lectio Divina* (praying the Bible) is taught and practiced. Next come five short meditations with devotional exercises on the prayers Jesus taught His disciples in the Our Father; praise, intercession, petitions, forgiveness and thanksgiving. Come with assurance that you can learn to discern God's voice through His Word and prayer.

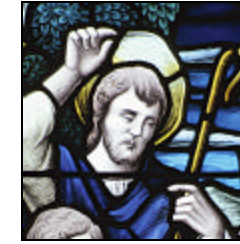
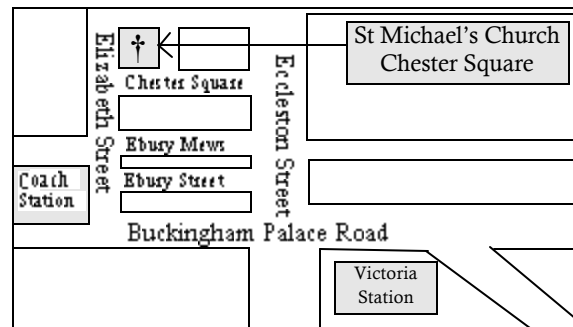
St. Michael's is a five minute walk from Victoria Station (train/tube/bus/coach).
